An orientation programme will be conducted to familiarise students at the Institute and the new environment upon arrival.

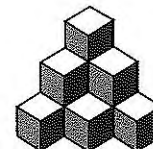
You may accept this Offer by taking the following steps in sequence:

- Sign the PEI-Student Contract;
- Deliver the Student Advisory Note and PEI-Student Contract to MDIS; and finally
- Pay the 1st instalment payment stated in the PEI-Student Contract to MDIS in full excluding any bank charges and exchange rate charges, and obtain a receipt issued by MDIS for your payment.

If you decide to withdraw from the course after accepting this Offer, you are entitled to do so and to a refund of fees paid as set out in the "REFUND POLICY" section of the PEI-Student Contract which you are advised to read in full before signing.

The Institute reserves the right to cancel any course due to unforeseen circumstances. In such circumstances, an alternative schedule will be offered to you. Should you decline to take up the offer; a full refund of your payment will be made, with the exception of the registration fee.

All full-time students are required to attend various workshops under the MDIS Experience. All workshops should be completed prior to your graduation and collection of certificates and transcripts.

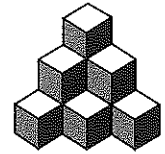

6. If payment is not received promptly, a late payment fee of S\$107.00 (inclusive of 7% GST) shall be levied.


Medical Examination

All international students at MDIS are required to undertake the **Urine Drug Test**, in addition to the Basic Medical Test (HIV screening and Digital Chest X-ray). Fees of these tests are included in the Non-Tuition Fees. The Urine Drug Test will detect the following: Phencyclidine, Cocaine, Amphetamines, Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and Opiates. **The Urine Drug Test must be done in Singapore.**

International students who do not pass the Drug Test will be withdrawn from MDIS and their Student's Pass Approval with ICA will be cancelled.
